The following Terms & Conditions (T&Cs) apply to JFK Tech Camps 2024. All fees quoted in Swiss Francs (CHF) currency, per student

In the interest of ensuring the best learning environment possible, all students are asked to follow the below Code of Conduct. JFK Tech Camp reserves the right to dismiss students, without prior warning, whose actions or influence are deemed unsatisfactory, dangerous or incompatible with the Program community or who will not comply with the rules and policies specified below.



Cancellation & Withdrawal Policy:

Up to 30 days before camp start date	Within 30 days of camp start date	
- Full refund of all amounts paid, whatever the reason	 No refund Partial Refund may be issued for cancellation due to medical reasons, such as hospitalisation or other extenuating circumstances that can be fully documented with a written explanation. 	

- 1. Changes (other than cancellations) can be made to any program up until 30 days prior to the start of camp.
- 2. JFK Tech Camp programme can be cancelled within 14 days of the course start date but there will be no refunds.
- 3. If JFK Tech Camp cancels a programme for any reason due to unforeseen circumstances, you will receive a full refund of the amounts paid or a credit voucher equivalent to the amount paid.
- 4. There are no refunds, credits, or replacement days for classes not attended.
- 5. Missed camps due to family emergencies or sickness will be reviewed on case-by-case basis.

Student Dismissal:

No refund, reduction or return of fee, or any part thereof will be made if a student is dismissed from the camp for disciplinary reasons or due to failure of the student to abide by the Code of Conduct.

Failure to Pay Invoices:

Invoices are payable prior to the start of camp. Applications are only accepted upon receipt of the signed Registration Form / General Terms and Conditions as well as the full payment.

JFK Tech Camp reserves the right to refuse entry to the camp and if necessary to exclude students from the camp if invoices are not settled before arrival.

Code of Conduct:

In order to maintain a safe and fun environment, students and parents/guardians of students participating in the JFK Tech Camp programme agree to adhere to these additional Code of Conduct requirements:

- 1. Students must treat all facilities, equipment, and people with respect.
- 2. Students must not possess or use drones, hoverboards, rollerblades, shoes with wheels, weapons, tobacco, marijuana, alcohol, or any illegal substances on campus.
- 3. Students must not disrupt, bully, intimidate, or harass others.
- 4. Students must not use inappropriate language (students cannot use curse words, racial, gendered, homophobic/transphobic, stereotypical, or culturally insensitive words, even in a joking manner) or view inappropriate content online.
- 5. Students must follow all rules and directives given by JFK Tech Camp and camp staff both on and off campus.
- 6. In the event that a parent cannot be reached in an emergency when the child is under JFK Tech Camp supervision, by accepting this Terms and Condition, the parent gives permission for JFK Tech Camp to act on their behalf in the best interest of the child.
- 7. All prescription medicine provided by a licensed Doctor must be turned into the camp/event staff upon arrival with clear, written instructions for administration in English. This will be dispensed by programme staff only. At the end of the program, parents are responsible for retrieving all medications and containers from staff. Medication left at event premises will be disposed of. Please note that JFK Tech Camp does not have professionally medically licensed staff.
- 8. All child's personal belongings are their own responsibility, unless loss or damage is proven to be due to JFK Tech Camp negligence. Refrain from bringing valuable items to camp.
- 9. Parents agree to pay for property damage caused as a result of negligent action of their child.
